

# Accessing ClassView Programs

## Logging in to iLit and myPerspectives ELD Companion

### Overview

To begin using ClassView programs (iLit, myPerspectives ELD Companion), teachers and students can log in directly through web apps (web browser) on their computers. ClassView programs are not supported using browsers on mobile devices. If you are using iPads, you will log in directly to the mobile app.

### Web Apps

### Mobile Apps

When using iPads, download the Teach iLit App and Learn iLit App by searching for “iLit” or “myELD” through the App Store icon on the device. The Projector App is only available as a web app..

### Logging in

The process of logging into the apps is the same for the Teacher, Projector, and Student Apps.

## Manually Rostered Users

If your classes were manually rostered in ClassView, complete the following steps from the login page on the web apps:

1. Select the organization.
2. Enter your username and password.
3. Click the *Login* button.

### Note:

You will use the same teacher credentials to log into both the Teacher App and the Projector App.

## Single Sign-On (EasyBridge)

If your classes were rostered through EasyBridge, you can sign in one of two ways.

- Log in directly from EasyBridge with your SSO credentials. Refer to the [EasyBridge Auto Rostering & ClassView iLit: Teacher Login & Initial Setup](#) support article for more details on logging in through EasyBridge.
- Log in using the *EasyBridge Customer?* link located on the web app login screen. Use the search bar to find your district, then sign in with your SSO credentials.

## Selecting A Class

After you have successfully logged in, you will see a list of classes.

1. Click on the row to highlight the class name.
2. Click the *Select* button to select the class.

### Notes:

- Classes may be hidden or re-ordered for more efficient selection.
- Select the same class for both the Teacher App and Projector App to maintain connectivity.
