

ROADS Retake/Correction Policy

ROADS teachers use the following retake/correction policy as an integral guide for helping students learn and achieve success.

Course Assessments:

- Students who fail an assessment other than a Midterm or Final Exam may complete a concept driven Curriculum Based Assessment (CBA). CBAs are administered via Chat or phone call to determine mastery and assign points for credit.
 - As an alternative, students can complete an alternative assessment following a review with a teacher via Chat or phone that addresses learning gaps.
- Students who fail the alternative assessment described above may complete a CBA via Chat or phone for additional credit.
- Students with a passing grade on an assessment may complete a CBA for additional credit.
- Dropbox assessments (i.e., essays, lab reports, PE logs) are automatically unlocked following instructional feedback for a maximum of three attempts. Additional corrections can be made after consultation with a teacher.

Midterm and Final Exams

- Students may correct errors on Midterms and Finals for 50% credit after reviewing with a teacher or completing teacher prompted study materials. Students must provide a Classmail explanation describing why the new answers are correct and/or why the previous answers were incorrect.
