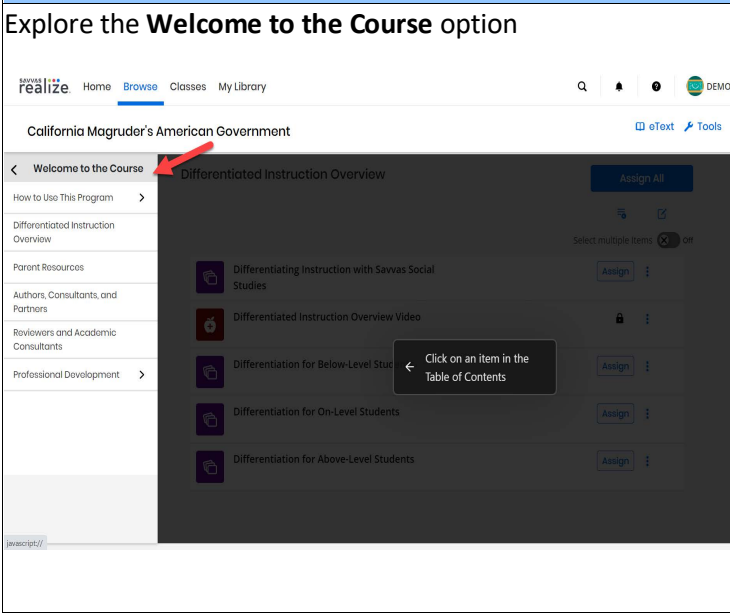


Use the Bookmark feature on the eText navigational pane to bookmark important pages within eText, including the materials in the Front Matter section.
