

hand side of the screen.






This is the program **Table of Contents** that lists each unit and its chapters. You can search by category (activities, resources, assessments, etc.) in the center of the page.


You can access eTexts for both the Student and Teacher Editions from this page by clicking **the book icon**.

Click **Lesson 2: Science in Context** to explore a lesson.




You can find digital activities here that correspond with the activities that are in the Teacher Edition. Here you will find the lesson labs, interactivities, videos and the lesson quiz.

Click **Assign** to assign the activity to a class, student, or group of students.






In the **Create an assignment** window, you can customize the assignment by adding a due date and instructions and specifying the students who will complete the activity.


