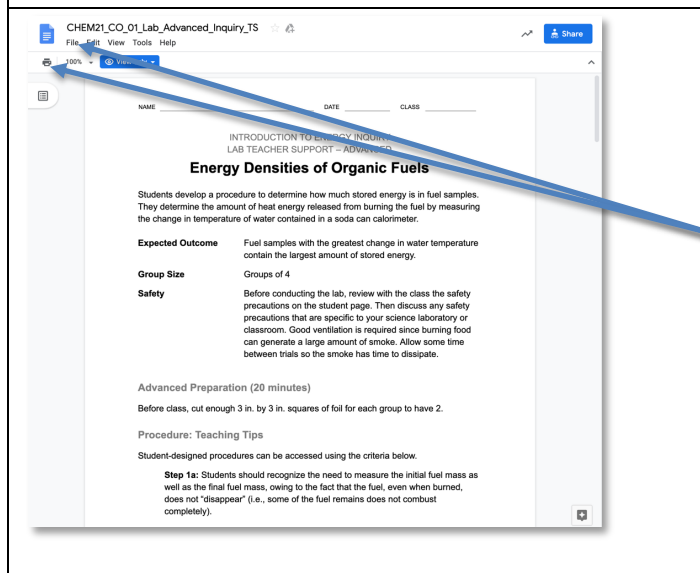
Each Inquiry Lab contains the following resources:

Choose one of the four versions of the lab:

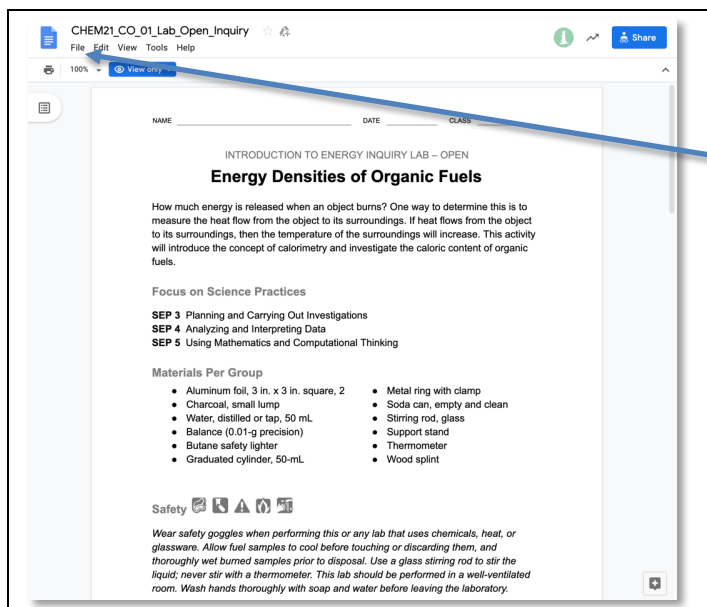
- Open-ended Inquiry
