Overview

Offline mode is a new functionality that enables students to access myPerspectives™ ELD Companion assignments and texts via the Learn myELD Student App without an Internet connection. This feature allows students to continue working on assignments while offline and access their Current Reading title and the current Read Aloud, Think Aloud text.

Once students reconnect to the Internet, all of their work is automatically saved to the cloud. Words and pages read are captured, as are all of the student activities data.



Access

This feature is embedded in the Learn myELD Student App for Chromebook™ notebook computers and iPads®. Download the updated version of the Learn myELD Student App from a device's official app store.

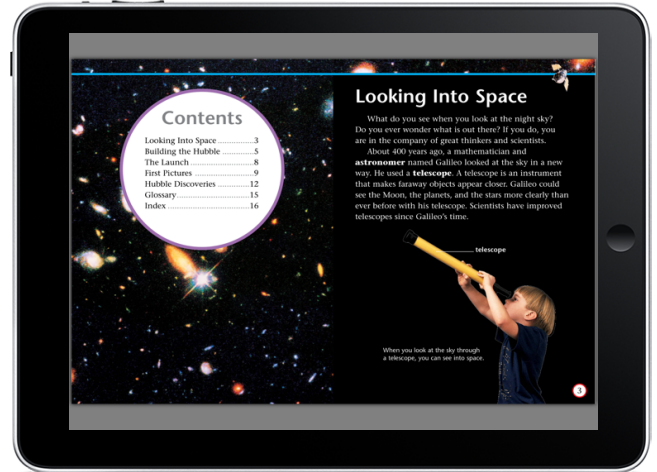

Preparing to Work Offline

Students must **open assignments or texts while online** and on the **same devices that they want to use offline**.

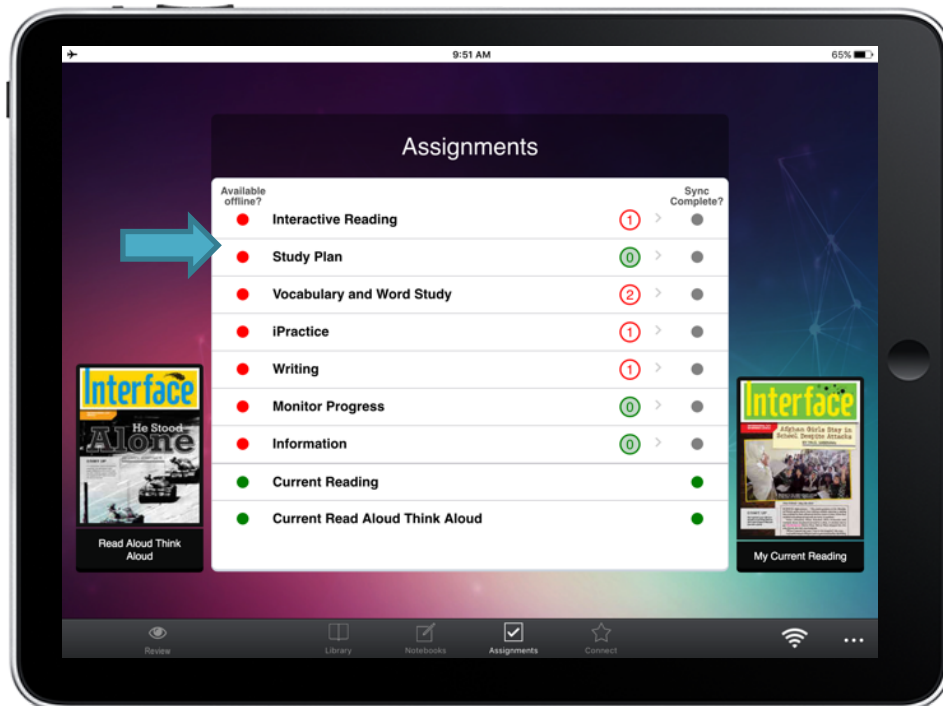
Once opened, assignments and texts are automatically saved to a device's file system and become available offline.

Students should log out of the Student App while they are online and log back in on the same device when they are ready to work offline. The Assignments tab will be the only active tab in this offline mode.



The **Available offline?** column indicates whether assignments are available offline.

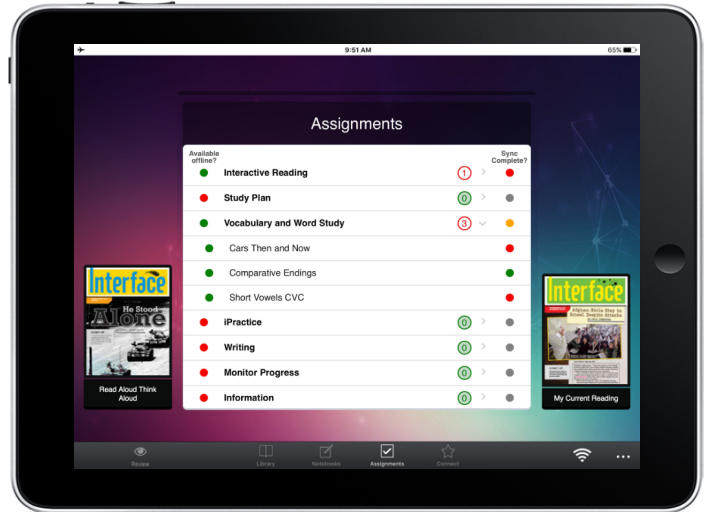
- **Red Circle:** Assignments in this category have not yet been assigned or opened on this device, so they are not available in offline mode.
- **Yellow Circle:** Some assignments within this category have already been launched online, but others have not yet been opened.
- **Green Circle:** Assignments in this category are available offline.



Working Offline

Students may launch and work on any assignment with a green indicator. They will be able to read Current Reading and Read Aloud, Think Aloud texts that they have previously opened.

- In this example, the only category available for offline use is Vocabulary and Word Study.
- Both the Read Aloud, Think Aloud text and My Current Reading are available offline.
- Some assignments require Internet access to provide students with feedback on their work prior to their final submission. Students can work on these assignments offline, but they cannot complete and submit the assignments until they are online again.



Syncing Student Work

When a device detects a Wi-Fi signal, student work will automatically begin to sync to the cloud. The user does not need to take any action to initiate this process.

The **Sync Complete?** column shows whether assignments have been synced.

- **Green Circle:** The assignment has been synced.
- **Yellow Circle:** The category features a blend of assignments—some assignments have been synced and some have not.
- **Red Circle:** The assignment has not yet been synced, or sync is in progress.
- **Grey Circle:** The assignment was not available for use in offline mode.
