You'll find the Chapter Opener, Chapter Close, Building Health Skills, and Lesson folders.

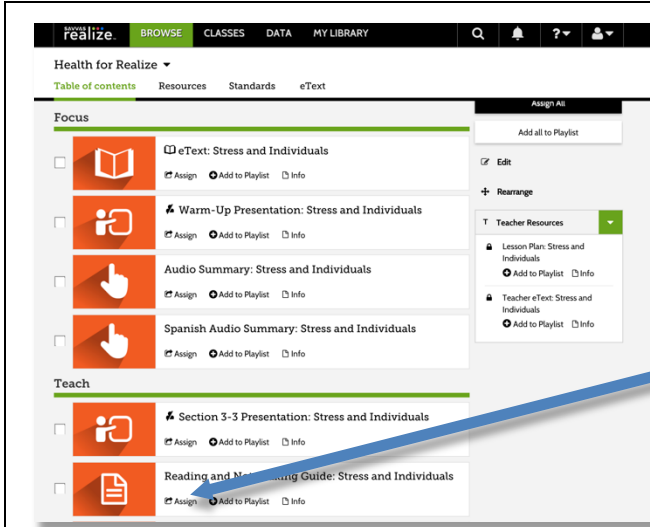
Click the **Chapter Opener** folder to see what can be found there.



Each Chapter Opener contains the eText for that chapter and the Teens Talk Video that is mentioned in the eText.

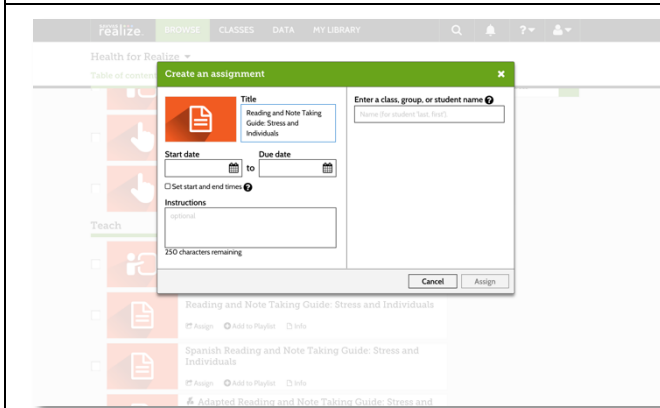
Click **Teacher Resources** when available to find additional resources such as video support and answer keys.

Click **Assign** to assign activities to a class, student, or group of students.

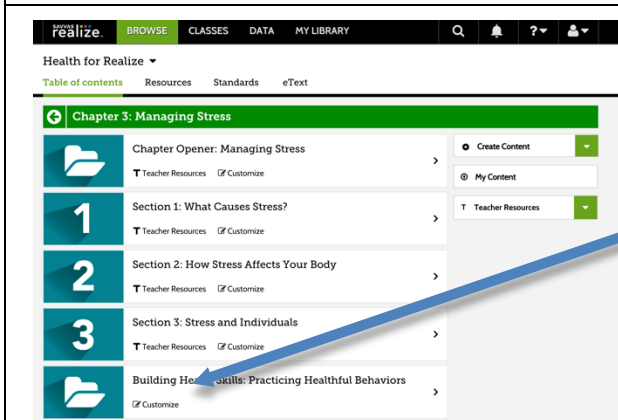


This window helps you customize the assignment by adding a due date and instructions and specifying the students who will complete the activity.
