Registering for IRC Access

1. Register at <https://register.pearsoncmg.com/reg/register/reg1.jsp>
2. Accept - Pearson License Agreement
3. Complete the online Access & Account Information.
Enter the following Access Code when prompted:

Downloading Resources

To access the resources for your textbook, simply follow the steps below:

1. Visit pearsonhighered.com/educator
2. Click into the Search bar at the top right.
3. Enter your textbook ISBN or locate your program by author and/or title.
4. Once you reach your textbooks product page, select the Resource tab to view the available resources. Downloadable resources will have a link.
5. Select the link for the resource to be downloaded.
6. When prompted to sign in, enter your personal log in and password you created during the registration process above. Files will automatically download. Only one file will download at a time.

TestGen TestBanks and Software

From the Resource Tab of the product page, you will see TestGen TestBanks if available for your program. The Software, including updates and plug ins, sits on it its own resource site. You can access this directly as listed below once you are registered for IRC access.

1. Visit pearsoned.com/testgen
2. Select Download TestGen materials, then select Downloads.
3. When prompted to sign in, enter your personal log in and password you created during the registration process above.
4. Download the TestGen Desktop Application for your PC or Mac.

†Educators will only need to register one time for access to the IRC. Once registered, the personal log in and password created will allow educators to download resources for all programs being reviewed.
