


Before Integrating with Realize	Notes
	<p>Your G Suite for Education account should be ready for use. Talk to your district or school for more information if you need help accessing a G Suite for Education account.</p>
	<p>Create a Google Classroom by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Navigating to classroom.google.com ● Login with your G Suite for Education (Google) credentials ● Click the + button at the top right-hand side of the page and then click Create class
<p>Using Classroom at a school with students?</p> <p>additional privacy and security protections that are important in a school setting. 


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Navigate in Realize	Notes
	<p>Login to Savvas Realize by using the steps given to you by your district or school, e.g., by clicking on the Savvas Easybridge link on your District Website OR District Clever Portal OR Classlink Portal OR ...</p>
	<p>Connect your Google Classroom by logging into Savvas Realize.</p> <p>Click on the  in the upper right hand corner of the page.</p> <p>Click on Settings</p> <p>NOTE: You MUST first add the applicable programs to your account by clicking on the My Programs tab.</p> <p>Scroll down to the applicable program, e.g., enVisionmath 2020 Common Core Grade 4</p> <p> the box.</p> <p>Click Save</p>
	<p>Next click back on the Account tab and scroll down until you see the Account Linking section.</p>
	<p>Click on Get Started</p>





	<p>If prompted, select or enter your Google Classroom sign in information.</p>
	<p>Next, when prompted, click Allow to grant Realize access to your Google Classroom account.</p>
	<p>Click on the Class you want to Link, e.g., Mr. Rogers 4th Grade. Then, click the Add Realize Programs to this Class pull down and click the correct program, e.g., enVisionmath Mathematics 2020 Common Core Grade 4.</p>




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	<p>Next, click Connect Class</p> <p>Finally, click Finish and View Classes</p>
	<p>Click on Classes then Students & Groups</p> <p>NOTE 1: Students will NOT show up under Students & Groups until they accept the invite to the class (see student flow). Check back after Students have accepted the invite.</p> <p>NOTE 2: Once Students accept the invite, they will show up under Students & Groups. Next to their name you will see Needs to Connect until they navigate to Realize for the 1st time (see student flow).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Note: If you do not see students that have purportedly accepted the invite, navigate back to Classes and click Sync with Google under the book icon.
	<p>If not already there, navigate back to the Classes Tab.</p> <p>Notice Google Classroom classes are delineated by the  icon, whereas Realize EasyBridge Classes do NOT have an icon.</p> <p>NOTE: If you are expecting ALL of your students / classes to navigate to Savvas Realize from Google Classroom, you may want to Hide your Savvas Easybridge classes by clicking  Hide class</p>



	<p>The next step is to Assign work to students by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navigating to the applicable program, e.g., enVisionmath Mathematics 202 Common Core Grade 4 • Navigate to the applicable Lesson resource you want to assign, e.g., 1-1: Generalize Place Value Understanding => Numbers Through One Million: Convince Me! <p>Click Assign</p>
	<p>Specify Start / Due date, Instructions, and select the appropriate class / student by starting to type the name, e.g., "Mr." to bring up Mr. Rogers classes OR "Will" to bring up a specific student with Will in their name.</p> <p>Click Assign</p> <p>IMPORTANT: You will ALWAYS need to be in Savvas Realize to assign and review student work. These activities are NOT possible from Google Classroom.</p>
	<p>Navigate back to Google Classroom and confirm the assignment(s) appear, e.g., 1-1: Generalize Place Value Understanding => Numbers Through One Million: Convince Me!</p> <p>NOTE 1: Your Google Classroom is now integrated with Realize. Rosters, Assignments, AND scores will now automatically sync.</p> <p>NOTE 2: Only students in the Realize class at the time the assignment is created will receive the assignment to complete. Students who join the class after an assignment has been posted will need to have the assignment assigned to them separately.</p>

	<p>You may want your students to have access to Realize directly without first needing to have at least one assignment – for example, if you simply want to give a student access to an eText through your Google Classroom. You can accomplish this by creating a Classwork Material link for the class within Google Classroom.</p> <p>Creating a Material link to Realize</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sign into your Google Classroom teacher account. 2. Click the class where you want the Material link to Realize. 3. Click the Classwork option at the top. 4. Click Create, and then select the Material option. 5. Multiple classes, select or All students can be selected from the For drop down menus 5. Supply a Title and Description (optional), and then click the link icon at the bottom. 6. Enter the following link: https://tinyurl.com/y6hsnvdq 7. Click Post.
