About ExamView

ExamView is an application that enables teachers to quickly create print and online tests. Teachers can enter their own questions and customize the appearance of the tests they create. The ExamView program offers many unique features, including a step-by-step process for building your own tests.

System Requirements

To use the ExamView® Assessment Suite Version 11, your computer must meet the following requirements.

PC Requirements

- Microsoft® Windows® 7, 8, or 10 (32-bit or 64-bit)
- Intel® Pentium® processor, 2 GHz or higher (or equivalent)
- 2 GB RAM
- 500 MB hard disk space
- Monitor capable of displaying 1024x768 or higher resolution
- An active internet connection to connect to Turning Technologies account, to ExamView Online Testing Service for the Premium license, to utilize the content update feature for selected publishers' content, and to publish an HTML test

Mac Requirements

- Mac® OS versions 10.10, 10.11, 10.12, 10.13, or 10.14 (Mac OS 10.15 is not supported at this time)
- Intel® processor, 2 GHz or higher (or equivalent)
- 32-bit or 64-bit Kernel and Extensions
- 2 GB RAM

- 300 MB hard disk space
- Monitor capable of displaying 1024x768 or higher resolution
- An active internet connection to connect to Turning Technologies account, to ExamView Online Testing Service for the Premium license, to utilize the content update feature for selected publishers' content, and to publish an HTML test

As an alternative to downloading ExamView via the product, we may be able to provide the ExamView application and item bank installers via a different type of media (e.g., email, SFTP, thumb drive, etc.).

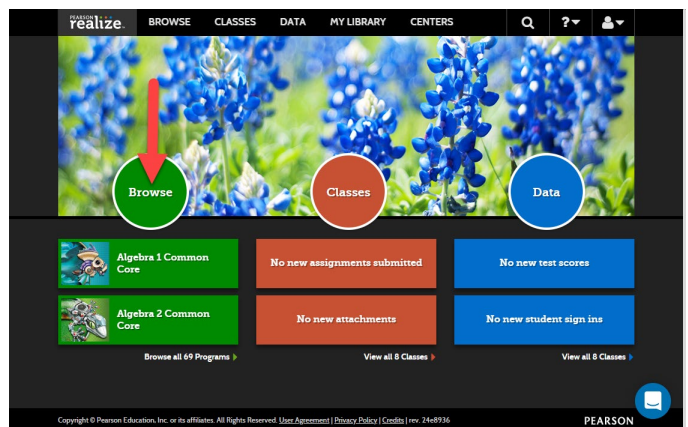
You will also need the rights to download and install the zip file and application. **Note:** These rights could be restricted by district technology settings.

Download ExamView from Savvas Realize

To download ExamView from Savvas Realize:

1. Log in to PearsonRealize.com.
2. Click **Browse** to access your programs.
3. Select your desired program.

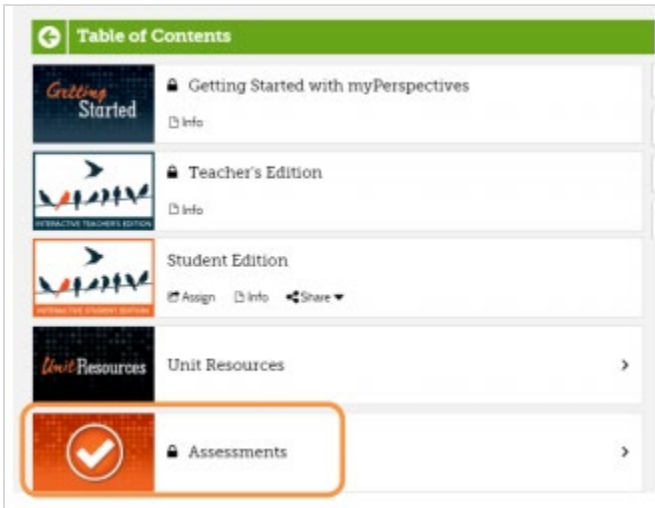
Note: Some programs do not have ExamView available.



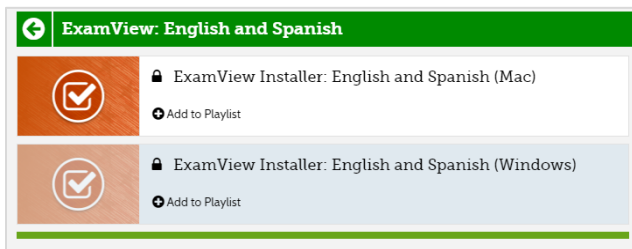
Depending on the program(s) you have access to, the method to download ExamView will vary.

Method 1: Download from Table of Contents



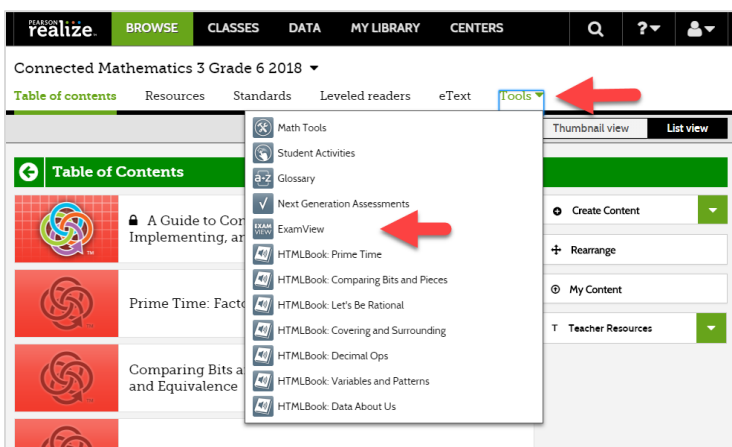
In the program Table of Contents, click the **Assessments** folder. Then click **ExamView**. **Note:** The link may differ for your program.



Select the appropriate ExamView installer (Mac or Windows). **Note:** Your options may vary.

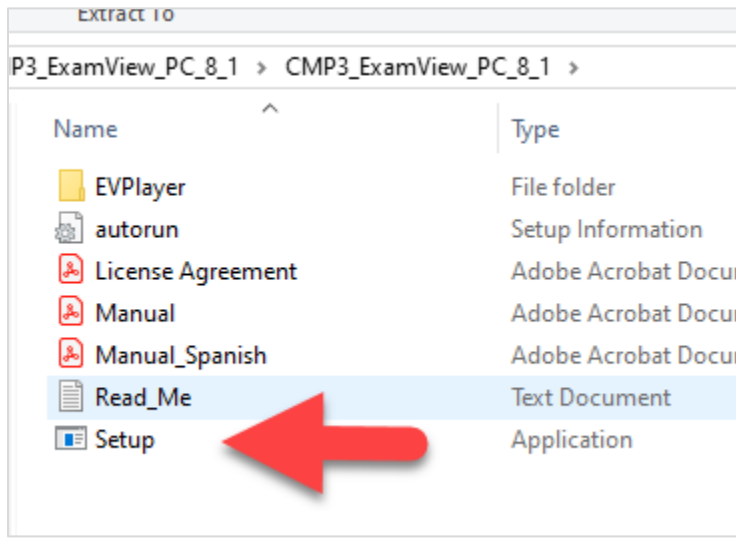
This step will initiate the download of the zip file containing the ExamView application and product-specific test item banks.

Method 2: Download from Menu Bar

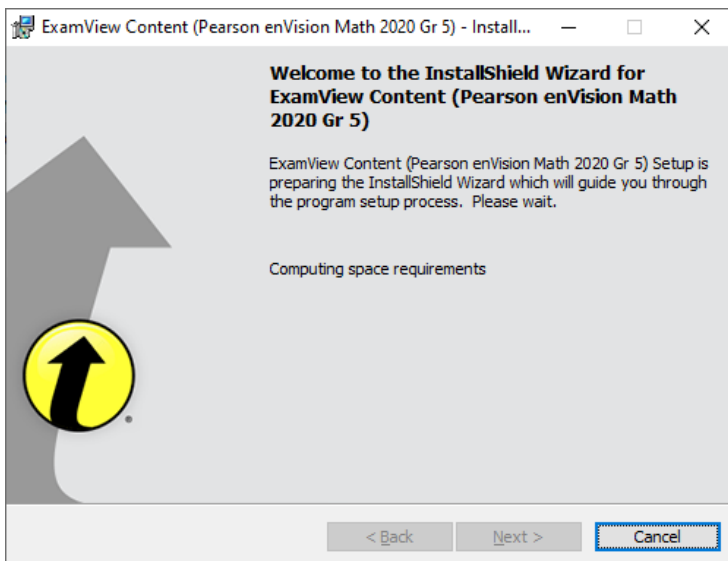


On the menu bar, select **Tools**. Then select **ExamView**. Your download should automatically start. If you are taken to a download page, locate the download link for your system and download ExamView.

Install ExamView

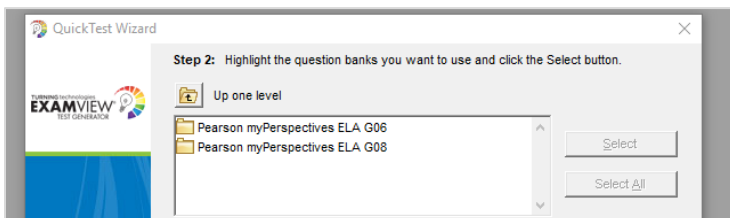


To install ExamView, locate the zip file and extract the contents. Open the folder and run the Setup application.



Follow the prompts to complete the installation.

Repeat the process for all products for which you want ExamView test item banks. Note that subsequent downloads will not reinstall the application but will only add test item banks to your program.



For example, in the visual to the left, you can see that the ExamView® Test Generator includes a separate folder for each test item bank that was downloaded.
