

How to Access *myPerspectives*™ ELD Companion on ClassView

Introduction

This handout explains how teachers using *myPerspectives*™ ELD Companion rostered in ClassView can access their program. ClassView is a learning platform used to set up classes and manage student rosters for the following literacy programs: *iLit* 90, *iLit* 45, *iLit* 20, *iLit* ELL, *myPerspectives*™ ELD Companion, and *Words Their Way*™ Digital.

Note: *This process is applicable for myPerspectives™ ELD Companion with Savvas EasyBridge Basic only. If you are a Savvas EasyBridge Plus or EasyBridge Auto school or district, click [here](#).*

Obtain ClassView Credentials

Teachers using *myPerspectives*™ ELD Companion should first contact their district or school administrator to obtain their teacher ClassView credentials. If your school or district does not have a dedicated ClassView administrator yet, a teacher can request an administrator account to fill this role.

Request ClassView administrator credentials

- The administrator is responsible for creating teacher accounts and distributing credentials to ClassView teachers.
- Click [here](#) to request a ClassView administrator account for your school. Look for two emails that include your new credentials, and setup details respectively.

Note: *It can take up to 24 hours for the emails to be generated.*

Request ClassView teacher credentials

- Teachers receive new credentials from their school or district administrator. Contact your school or district administrator if you have not received credentials. All other questions, contact [Savvas K-12 Support](#). Select **Other** in the product selection drop down menu. Then enter **ELD Companion - ClassView Credentials** in the text box provided. Complete the form.

Manual Roster Students and Teachers in ClassView

For schools and districts using Savvas EasyBridge *Basic* with their literacy programs, student rostering and class setup is completed in ClassView. Detailed steps for the

- Add students to new or existing classes
- Bulk upload users

Using ELD Companion from Savvas Realize

EasyBridge Basic users accessing *ELD Companion* can begin using their teacher accounts from Savvas Realize after receiving their ClassView teacher username and password from their administrator.

Note: *Savvas EasyBridge Auto or Plus users can access ELD Companion directly with the ClassView integration.*

Follow the steps below to access the *ELD Companion* from Realize:

1. Go to Savvas Realize and sign in. (www.savvasrealize.com)
2. Click the *ELD Companion* icon on the *myPerspectives* **Table of Contents** menu.
3. Enter your ClassView teacher credentials to access the *ELD Companion* content.

Note: *If your browser is configured to remember passwords, you will not be prompted to login to Realize each time.*
