


You can find all the activities and links for each Investigation here. You will see links to the Teacher and Student Edition, followed by each problem, ACE exercises, and Mathematical Reflections.




Next, you will see some of the resources that you will use to teach a lesson. You will find the Focus Question and Launch videos or Teacher Connection videos (if applicable) here.


This is the Course Overview page of the Realizer Reader eText. (The eText links within a Unit, Investigation, or Problem will take you directly to those places.)


