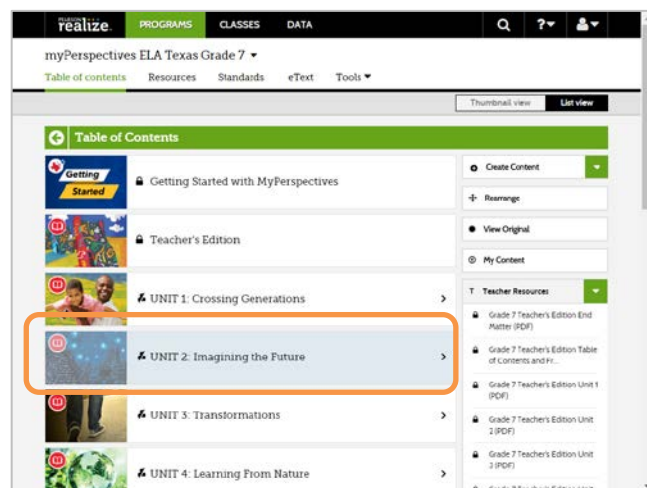
In the Table of Contents, scroll down and click the **Audio/Video: Student Edition** tab.

Explore the **Resources**.

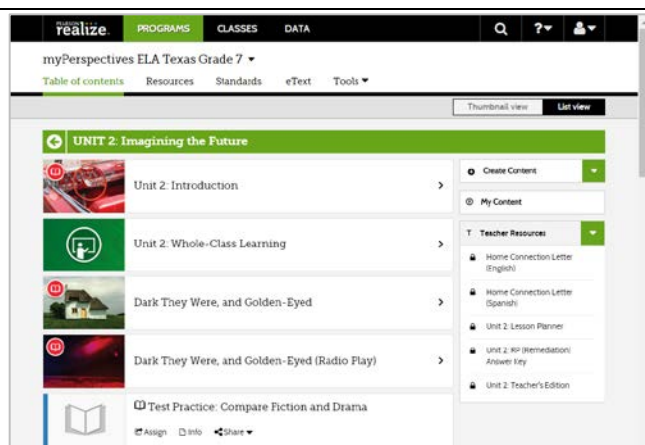


In the Table of Contents, click a unit you would like to explore.

- Note the handy Home Connection Letter (Spanish and English) in the Teacher Resources drop-down menu.

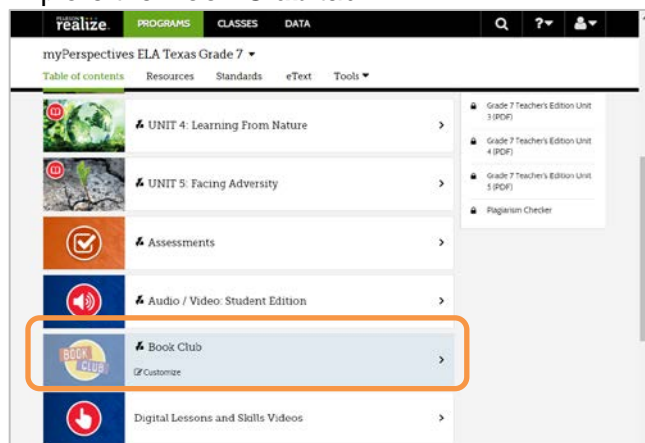

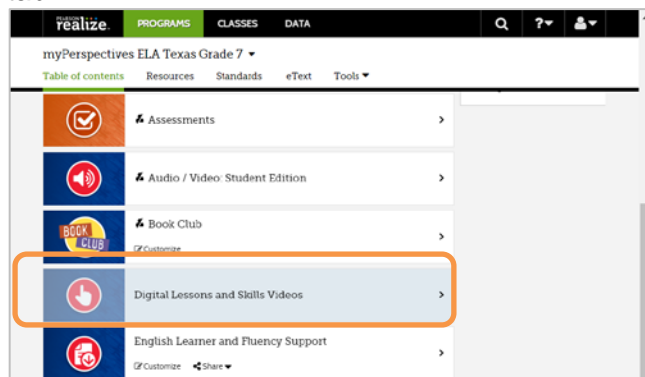

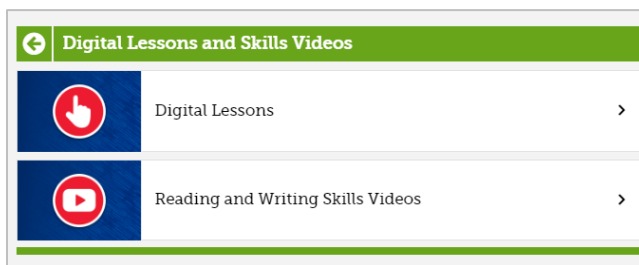

Explore the **Digital Lessons and Skills Videos** tab.

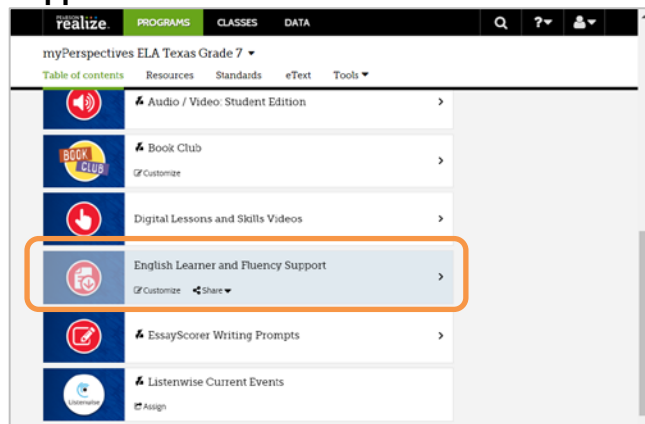


In the Table of Contents, scroll down and click the **Digital Lessons and Skills Videos** tab.

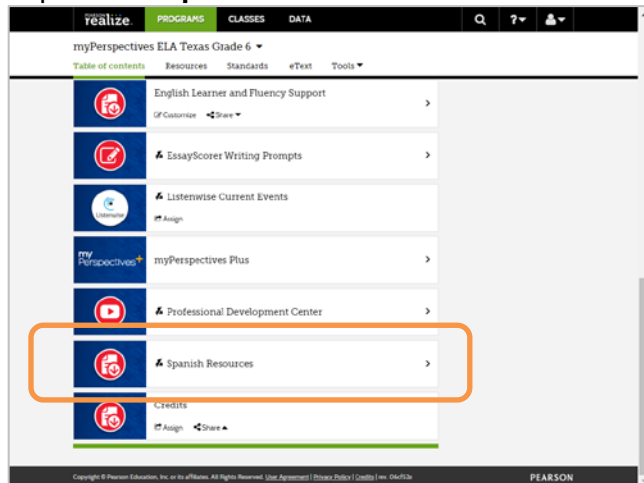
