

Accessing ClassView Programs

Logging in to iLit and myPerspectives ELD Companion

To begin using ClassView programs (iLit, myPerspectives ELD Companion), teachers and students can log in directly through mobile apps on their phone or iPad or web apps on their computer. **Note: ClassView programs are not supported on browsers on mobile devices. Mobile apps are recommended for iPad or Chromebook users.*

Web Apps

Web apps can be launched using the following URLs:

For iLit:

- **teachilit.com** (iLit teacher app)
- **learnilit.com** (iLit student app)
- **projectilit.com** (iLit projector app)

For myPerspectives ELD Companion (myELD):

- **teachmyeld.com** (myELD teacher app)
- **learnmyeld.com** (myELD student app)
- **projectmyeld.com** (myELD projector app)

Mobile Apps

Mobile apps can be downloaded from the following app stores. **Note: the projector app is only available as a web app.*

iPad:

Use the App Store icon on your iPad to download teacher and student apps. Search for “iLit” or “myELD” to locate available apps.

Chromebook:

Use the Chrome Web Store icon on your Chromebook to download teacher and student apps. Search for “iLit” or “myELD” to locate available apps.

**Remember!: Apps should be deleted and re-downloaded at the beginning of each school year.*

Logging in

Manually Rostered Users

From the login page, select the organization and enter your username and password.



Tips!

- Logging into the apps is the same for the teacher, student and projector apps.
- Use your teacher credentials to log into the projector app. Select the same class for both the teacher app and project app to maintain connectivity.

Single Sign-on (EasyBridge)

EasyBridge customers may SSO into the web apps from EasyBridge or through the ClassView Landing Page. To log in from the ClassView landing page, click **EasyBridge Customer?** at the bottom of the screen. Select your organization, then use your district credentials to log in.

**Note: You cannot SSO into mobile apps. District credentials should be used to log into mobile apps.*

After logging in, you will see a list of classes. Click the appropriate row, then click Select to select your class (screenshot below).

**Note: Classes may be hidden or re-ordered for more efficient selection.*
