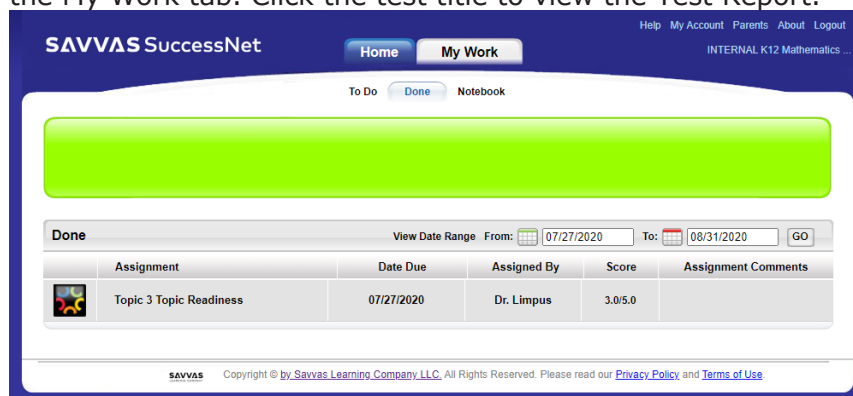


## Teachers—How Parents and Students Review Test Results

**Introduction** This guide explains how parents and students review test results on Savvas SuccessNet®. Reviewing test results helps students and their parents understand which skills have been mastered and which skills need to be studied or relearned.

**Student View** To view lesson progress and test results, parents and students sign in to Savvas SuccessNet® using the student username and password. Click **To Do** on the student Home page, and then select **Done** under the My Work tab. Click the test title to view the Test Report.



**Parent Access** Parents can also select **Parents** on the top right-hand side of the student Home page to view test progress. Select **Test Progress** to view progress students have made on tests.

**Test Progress** The Test Progress page lists the Assignment Name, Score, Date Taken, Status, and the name of the teacher who assigned the test.

Click **View results** next to the test name to view the Test Report.

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### **Test Report**

The Test Report is the same for students and parents. The left side of the report shows the score, a list of skills the student successfully completed, and a list of topics that need more work.

The right side of the report shows a list of the test question numbers. A green circle indicates the question indicates a correct response. A red x indicates an incorrect response.

If your Savvas SuccessNet® district administrator allows parents and students to view individual test items, click a question number to see the test question, possible answers, and the chosen answer. Parents and students will only be able to view individual questions on a test if this preference has been enabled by a Savvas SuccessNet® district administrator.
