Send Assignments with Due Dates

Teachers can now send any assignment with an assigned due date. This includes **Core Assignments**, **Extra Practice Assignments, and GRADE**. Along with the due date, new color coding in the Teacher digital experience lets teachers easily see what has been assigned with a due date, assignments turned in past the due date, and assignments that the teacher needs to grade.

On the **Organizer Tab:**

- 1. Click on **Assignments** on the right side (or you may select GRADE if you would like to assign this)
- 2. Select the assignment you would like to assign
- 3. Click on the Send icon with the Calendar
- 4. Select the desired due date
- 5. Click "OK"
- 6. View Progress Tab for new color coding

iLit45 & iLitELL

On the **Assignments Tab:**

- 1. Click on Select
- 2. Select the assignment
- 3. Click the **Send All** button with the calendar icon
- 4. Select the desired due date
- 5. Click "OK"
- 6. View new color coding on Assignments Tab

Reports

ClassView users can now export the **Student Gradebook Report** and **Weekly Students Assignment Report**, which will now show the **Assigned Date**, **Due Date**, **and Submitted Date**.

Partial Scoring for *iLit45* & *iLitELL*

Teacher Digital Experience: Teachers will now be able to trigger the scoring mechanism for both system-graded as well as teacher-graded Assignments by clicking on the sent assignment and clicking on Partial Score when the assignment is **In Progress** state.



- For Assignments sent without any Due Date, the assignments can be Partial Scored at any time after it has been sent to the student.
- For Assignments sent with a Due Date, the assignments can be Partial Scored only *after the Due Date has passed* and after it has been sent to the student.
- The Assignments sent with or without a Due Date will consider the Date of triggering the Partial Score as the Submitted Timestamp.

Student Digital Experience: If an assignment has been partially scored, a student won't be able to attempt the assignment again unless the assignment is withdrawn and sent again.

Rescore and Reassign

Within *iLit45* and *iLitELL*, teachers will now be able to **Rescore the Teacher Graded Assignments** that they have previously scored. On the **Assignments Tab**, the teacher will be able to score or withdraw. GRADE can also be reassigned.

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Other Updates

- Ability for ClassView district administrators and school administrators to reset their password
- Updates to the **Play/Pause**, **Audio Duration**, **Interactive Progress Bar**, **Mute/Unmute** button for Read Aloud Think Aloud and Interactive Readers
- Ability to subtract select users from broadcast (rather than add individually)

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
