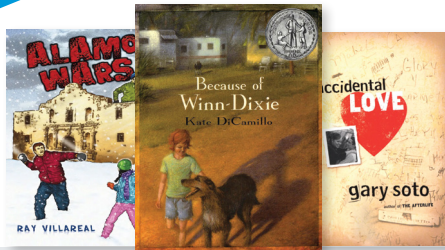

iLit Read Aloud, Think Aloud Books (Levels A-G)

Non-proficient readers need to experience how a skilled reader approaches a rigorous text. That's the goal of Read Aloud, Think Aloud. *iLit* takes a grade-level text and has the teacher read it aloud, stopping frequently to show how to unlock meaning. The Read Aloud, Think Aloud text anchors *iLit*'s instruction.
