

WRITING

- 1 PLAN**
Read the prompt and develop a plan for what you are going to write.
- 2 DRAFT**
Using the plan that you have developed, draft your paragraph or essay. Don't worry about errors; just keep the flow going.
- 3 REVISE**
After you have completed your draft, read what you have written. (It helps to read it aloud.) Make sure that you have addressed the prompt, said what you want to say, and have written a response that makes sense.
- 4 EDIT**
After you have revised, reread your draft again and correct errors such as typos, misspelled words, missing or repeated words, incorrect punctuation, and so on.
- 5 GET FEEDBACK**
Tap the Get Feedback button to see a score for your writing. Continue to revise your writing based on the feedback.
- 6 SUBMIT**
When you are satisfied with what you have written, tap Submit so that your teacher can read and evaluate your writing.
- 7 PRESENT**
Sometimes your teacher may ask you to present your writing to the class. Read your writing in a clear, strong voice and with expression.
